II. AWARD SPECIFICATIONS

- A. The number of awards to be made each year is two; \$2,500.00 for each recipient per semester, with the proviso that the recipient meets the maintenance requirement specified in Article V. , Paragraph B (below).
- B. This scholarship is generally not awarded in the Summer Semester.
- C. Awarded to registered full-time student(s) only.

V. ELIGIBILITY

- A. In order to be eligible to apply for the scholarship he/she should:
 - 1. Preferably be a US Citizen
 - 2. Preferably be a Louisiana Resident
 - 3. Be a sophomore, junior, or senior with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA
 - 4. Must be majoring in Petroleum Services in the College of Arts and Sciences, Department of Applied Sciences
 - 5. Complete and Submit a resume, an AADE Scholarship Questionnaire (see below), and a short (500 words or less) statement of need for review by the Scholarship Selection Committee.
 - 6. An interest in drilling would be a positive factor, but not a requirement.
- B. Maintenance Requirements:

In order for a student to receive the second portion of his/her scholarship, the student must successfully complete the semester as a full-time student and have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA.

VI. HISTORY

Recognizing the importance of drilling to the oil and gas industry and the need to attract professional talent and maintain a high level of technical proficiency within the drilling business, the AADE as part of its bylaws awards scholarships to students who are enrolled, or planning to enroll, in Petroleum Engineering who demonstrate scholastic aptitude by overall GPA, and who demonstrate financial need. The current bylaws are restrictive to Petroleum Services. In the future other engineering disciplines such as mechanical and chemical could be considered. The organization will communicate this to the university. An interest in “drilling” is a positive factor in awarding this scholarship.
