

2009—2010 VERIFICATION OF PARENT MARITAL STATUS

INSTRUCTIONS: Due to conflicting information you reported on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), you must verify your parents' current marital status.

When you completed your FAFSA, you **either** reported incomes inconsistent with your parents' reported marital status, left your parents' marital status blank, or reported information that caused the Federal Processing Center to assume your parents' marital status.

To clear up this discrepancy or missing information, you must submit the following:

- 1.) A signed statement from you explaining the reason for the discrepancy.

AND

- 2.) A signed statement from your parent (whose information was provided on your FAFSA) indicating his/her **CURRENT** marital status.

You may be required to submit additional documentation of your parents' current marital status once the above statements are received.
