## For Your Information

Students that are interested in taking any kind of standardized test, such as ACT, must apply well in advance in order to take this type of test with accommodations. Applicants must be approved before taking the test, and the approval may take up to eight weeks. If you are currently using accommodations, it is highly recommended that extended time as an accommodation be requested in the application for accommodations. High school guidance counselors should be contacted for more information.
