Although the main objective of the Center staff is to assist students in the implementation of their legal accommodations, the Center is also responsible for screening students with learning disabilities for placement in the Dyslexia Center, providing support services for college students in organizing class schedules, tutoring students in areas of academic difficulty, and instructing students in remedial math and English college classes when needed. The staff is also dedicated to providing information to the public through phone calls, workshops, and individual contacts, and working cooperatively with administration, parents, and colleagues to ensure the educational path for the students.
