^{*}ABA option - A master's degree is required to take the course work necessary to sit for the BCBA exam. Candidates seeking a master's degree + ABA must follow the HID + ABA curriculum plan. An individual currently holding a masters degree in Education, Psychology or a related field are ONLY required to take the 6 core ABA courses + 2 additional advanced practicum courses listed. You may be exempted from the advanced practicum courses provided the candidate is obtaining field experience hours from another approved source. This must be approved by the program chair.

^{**}Educational Diagnostician Certification- A master's degree in education in required to obtain this certification. Those individuals seeking this certification who do not have a master's degree must follow the ABA + EDC curriculum plan. In addition you must also hold a teaching certificate in special education and 1 year of teaching experience in special education.

***Add-on Certification in Special Education- To obtain an add-on certification you must possess a teaching certification in another area. You may elect to take add-on certification courses in special education at the undergraduate level to obtain the special education add-on. If you take all of the AOC courses you are eligible for special education certification across all grade bands. Please note that if you take the undergraduate add-on courses you cannot transfer these to a graduate program nor will they be counted towards a plus-30 requirement. Candidates who wish to also obtain a special education certification as part of the master's degree will be required to follow the HID + AOC curriculum plan.
