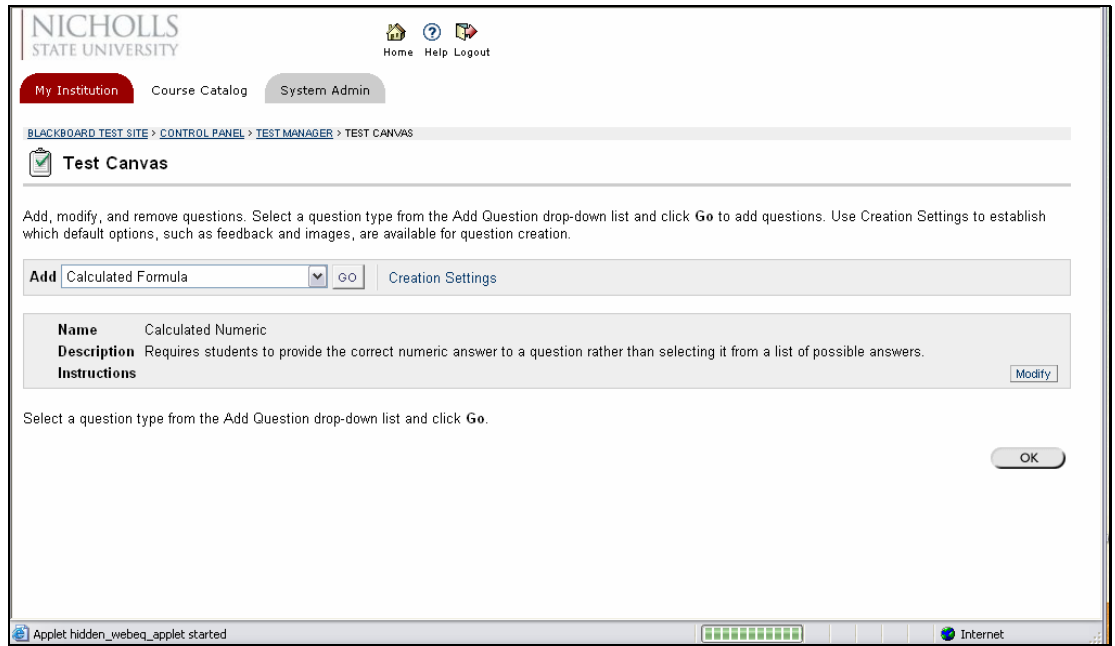


# CALCULATED NUMERIC

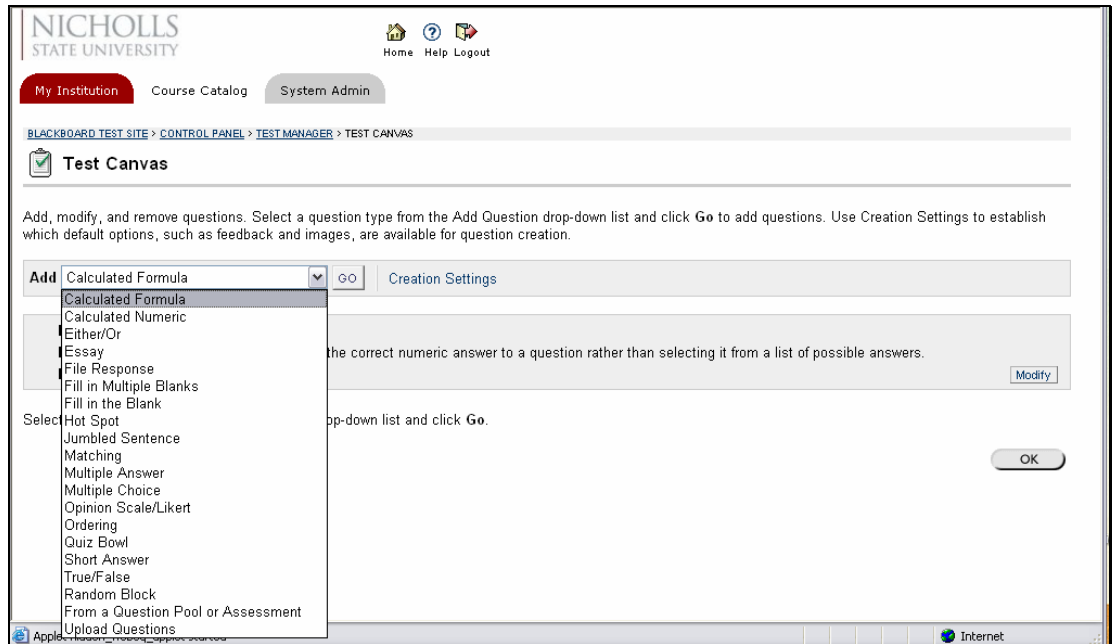
Access the Test Canvas page.
