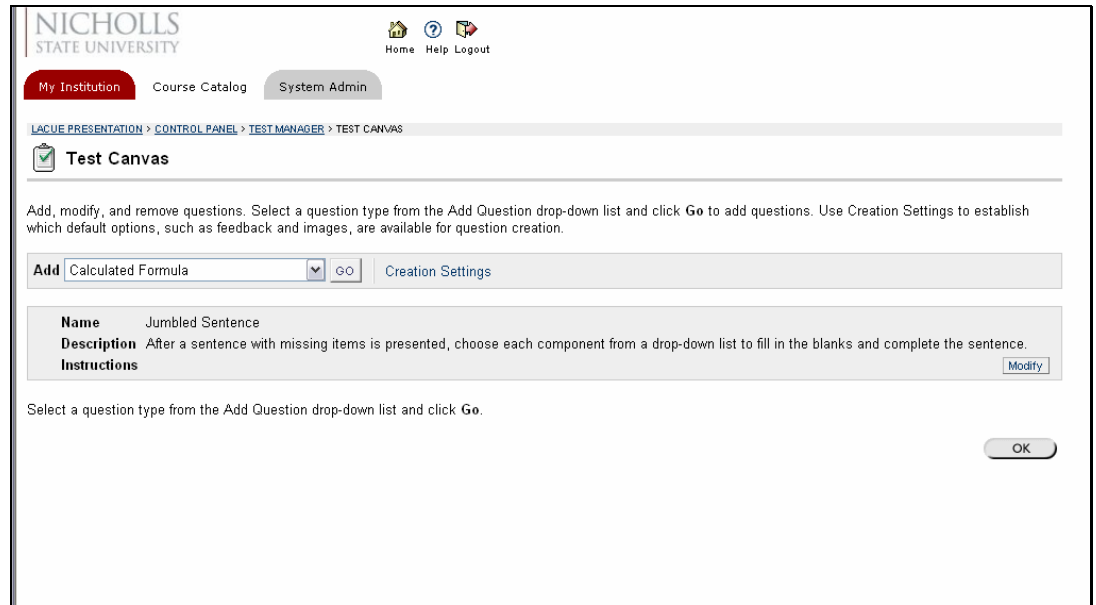

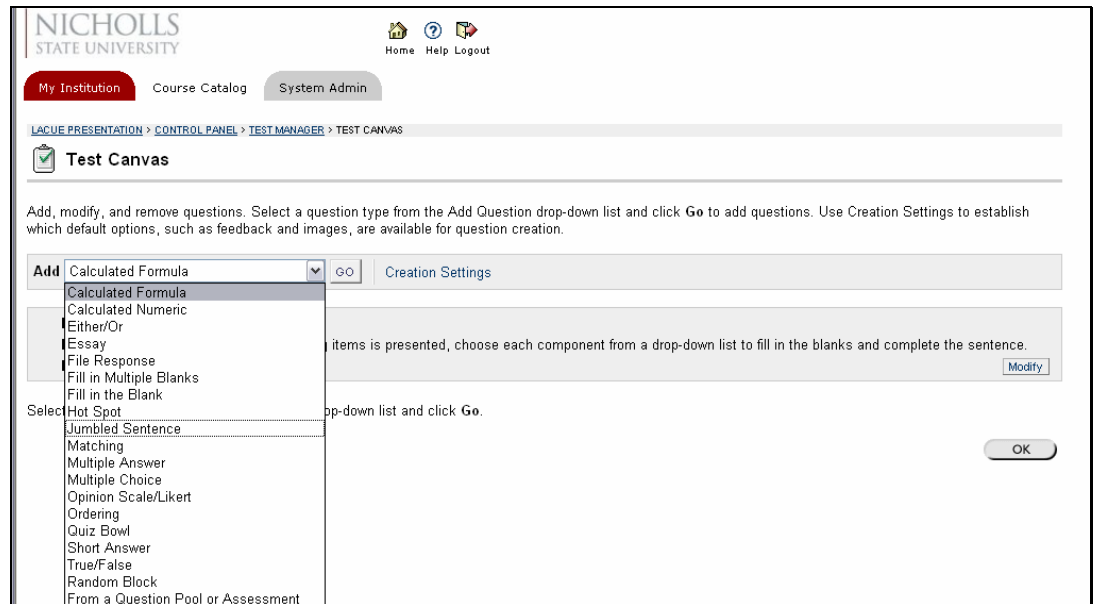
Access the Test Canvas page.
