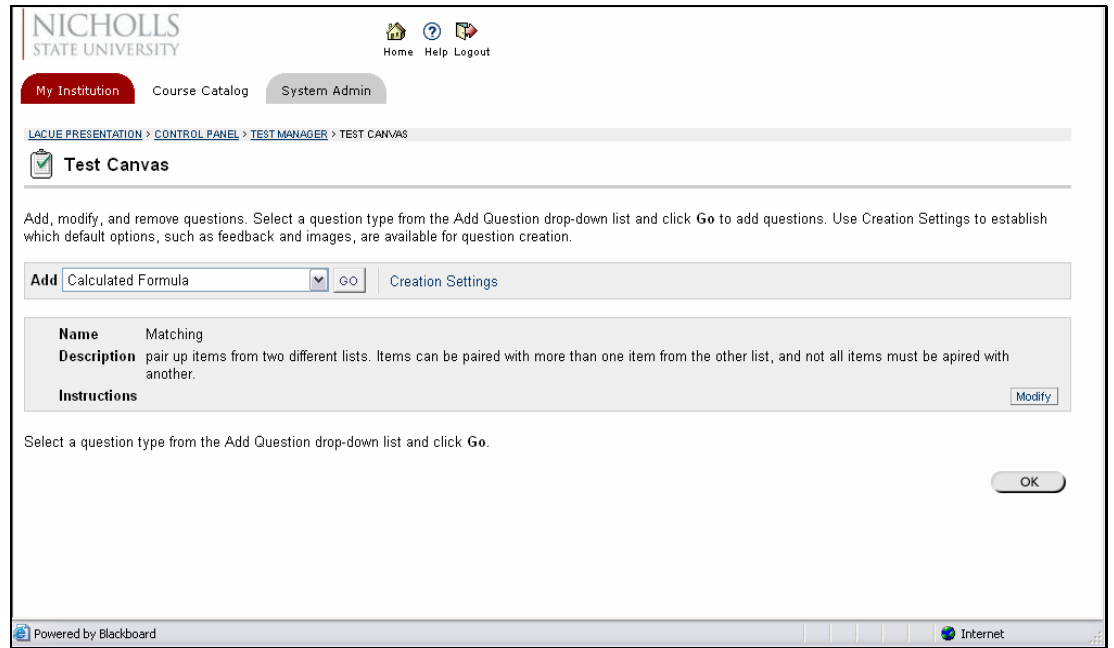

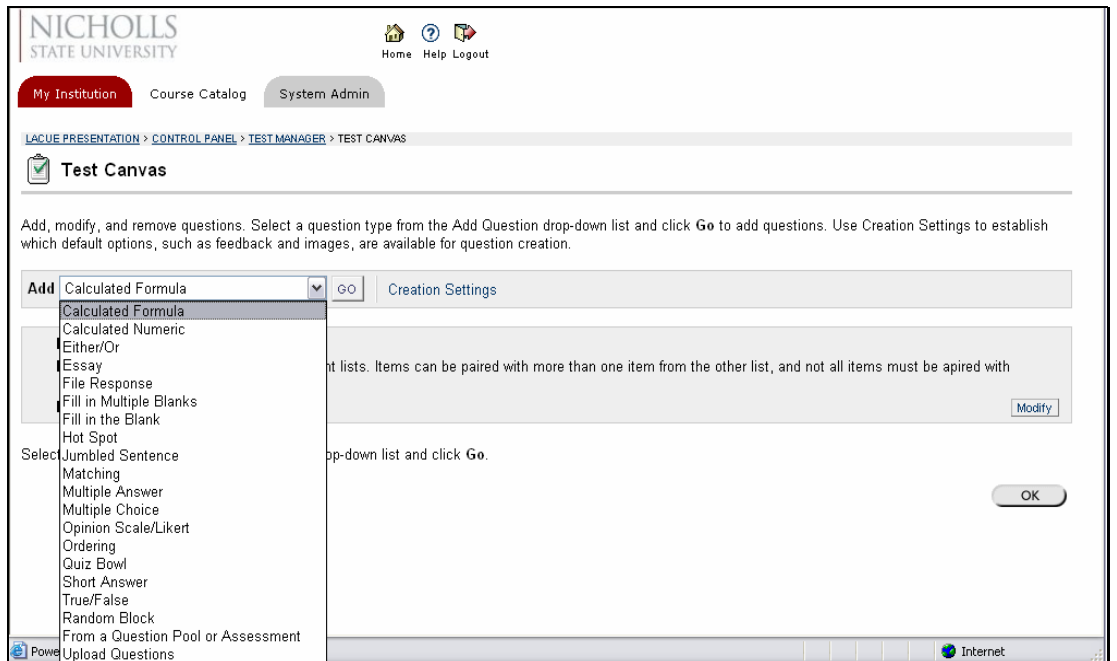
Access the Test Canvas page.

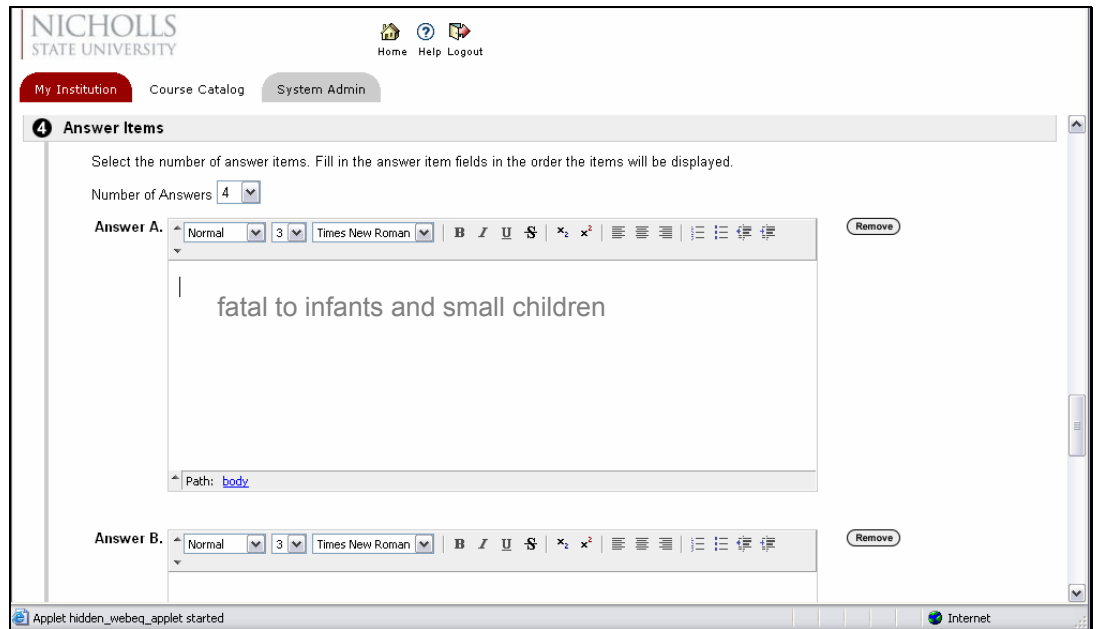

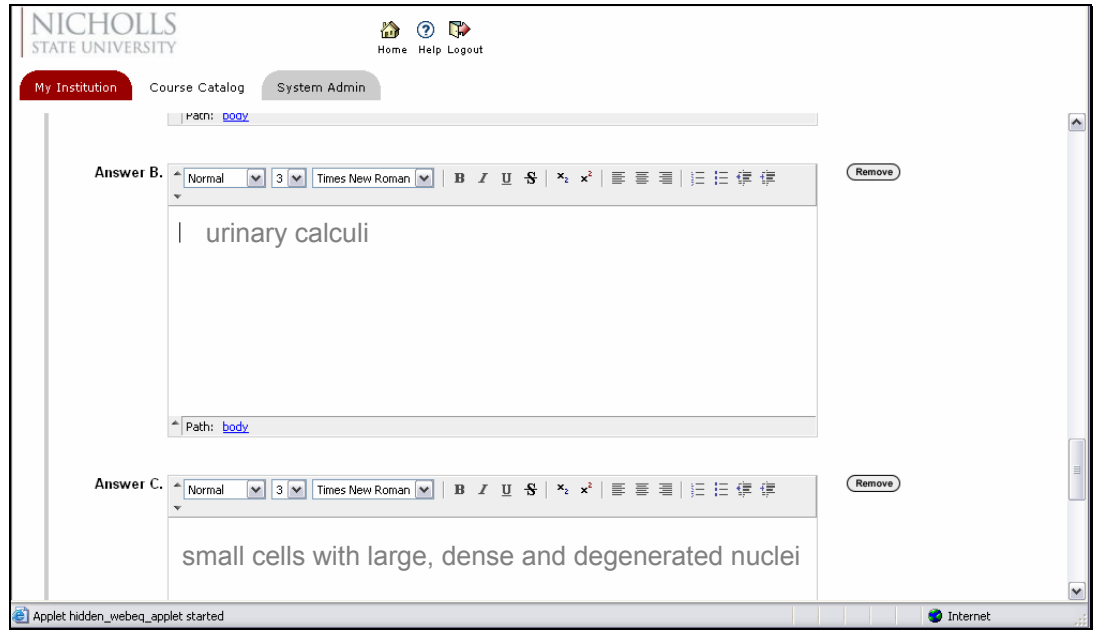
Type one answer item in each of the **Answer** textboxes.

NOTE: For this demonstration, we are using an equal number of questions and answers. It is possible to have answers that do NOT correspond to a question item.

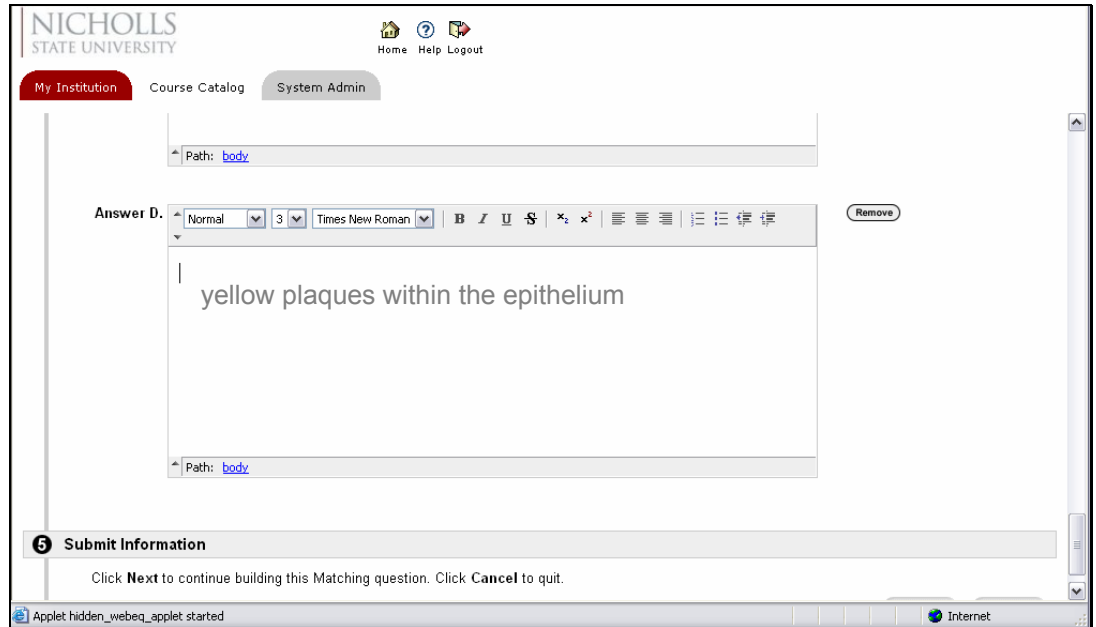
