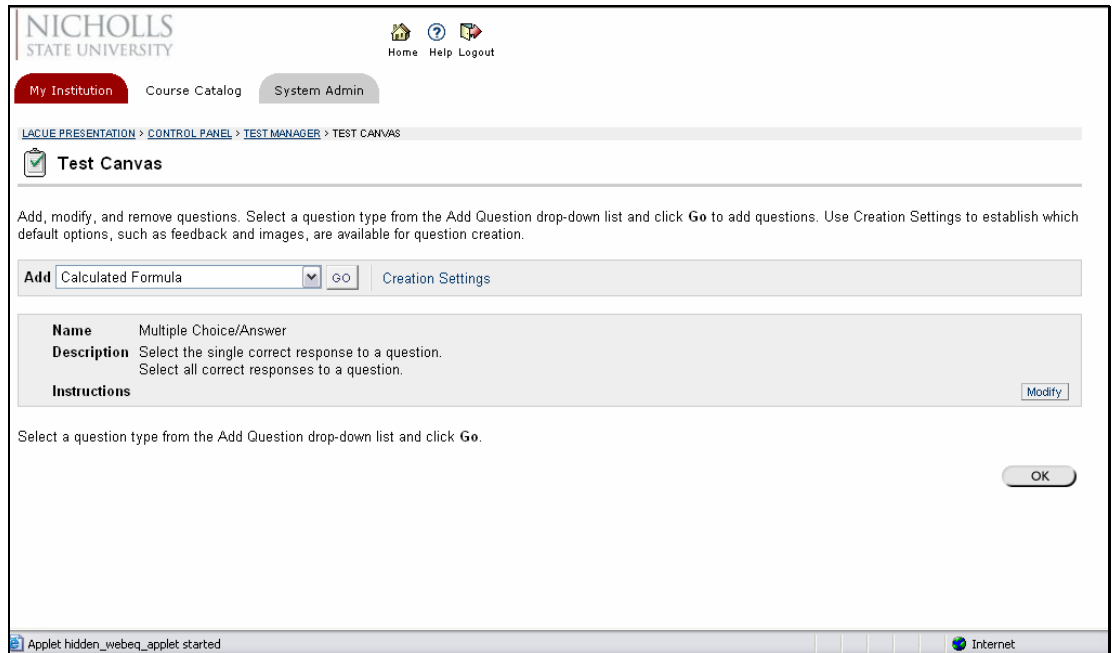


MULTIPLE CHOICE and MULTIPLE ANSWER

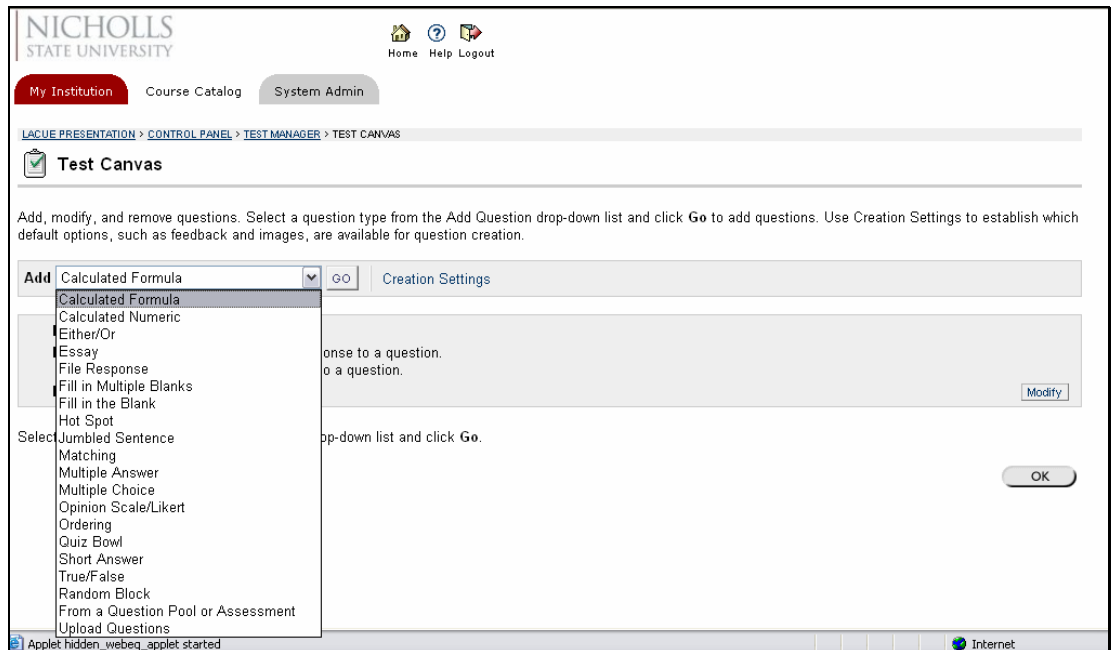
Access the Test Canvas page.

Click the drop-down list to the left of the GO button to display a list of question types.



Select the **Multiple Choice** item

Click **Go**.



Type the question in the Question Text textbox.

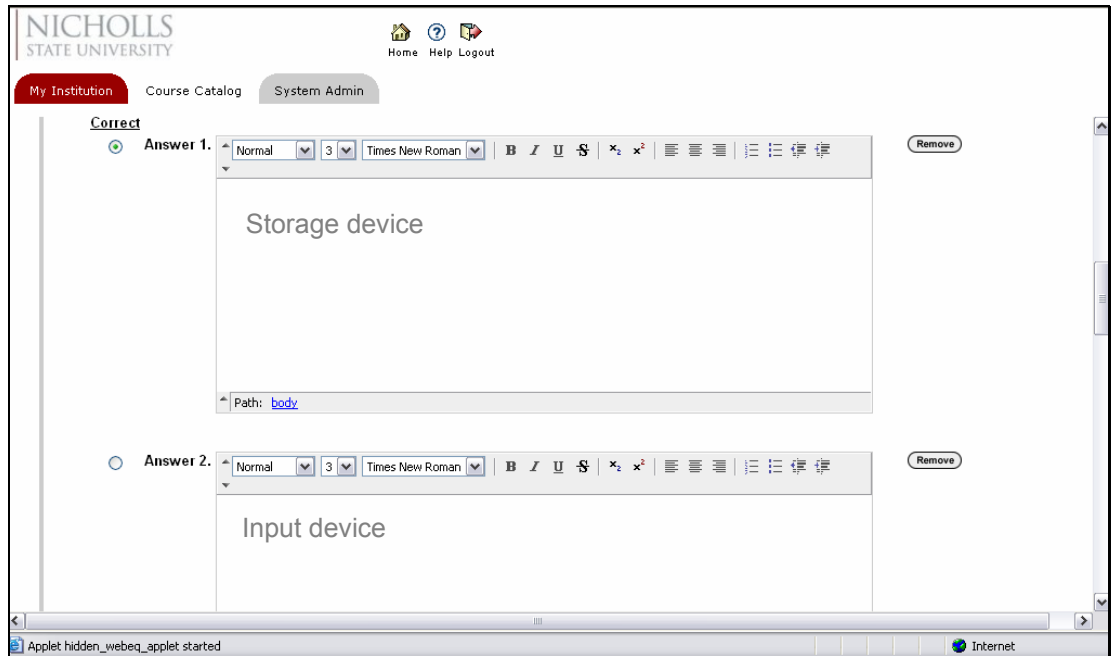

Type each possible answer in a separate textbox.

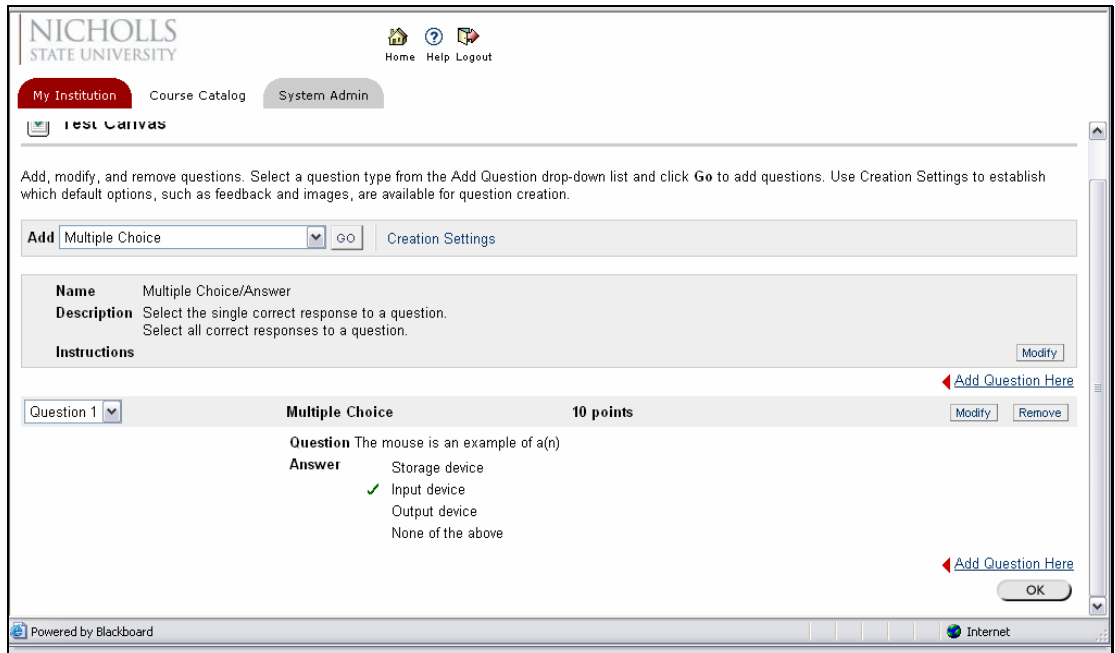
To indicate the correct response, click the option button next to the answer number.
