

## GRADUATE COURSE VERIFICATION

INSTRUCTIONS: Complete this form and return it to our office by the deadline date indicated on your Missing Information Letter (MIL).

Because you are a graduate student, we must verify that you will be enrolling with the number of graduate level hours required to receive a graduate level loan.

Graduate loan limits apply only when you have been admitted as a degree candidate in a graduate program and have begun to take enough courses to qualify as at least a half-time student on the graduate level. If you enroll with preparatory coursework to enter a graduate or professional program, you are eligible to receive financial aid for a period of one calendar year (12 month consecutive period) at annual loan limits established for fifth year undergraduates.

Please read the following statements and check the one that applies to your situation.

I will enroll with at least six hours of courses that count toward my graduate degree (This does not include prerequisite courses.) during any semester I enroll in the 2007/ 2008 award year (Fall 2007/Spring 2008). I will remain enrolled with the required number of hours through the 14<sup>th</sup> day of classes, the date that records become official. I understand that I may be required to repay any amount awarded to me if I do not remain officially enrolled in the required number of graduate level hours.

**OR**

I will enroll with at least six hours of undergraduate level courses during any semester I enroll in the 2007/ 2008 award year (Fall 2007/Spring 2008). If I enroll in graduate prerequisite courses, a certification program or a pre-certification program, please process my loans at the annual loan limit established for a fifth year undergraduate.
