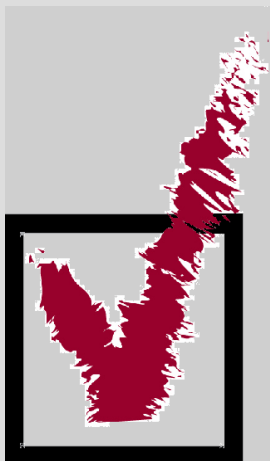

Nicholls State University is moving closer to its goal of becoming a greener campus. This semester marks the introduction of a campus-wide paper recycling program aimed at recycling office paper, newspaper, magazines, catalogs, phone books and text books. Dr. Stephen Hulbert urged campus departments and offices to use the new paper recycling depositories located near University Printing and the tennis courts to recycle paper materials from their offices and areas.



New paper recycling bins, like this one, are now located in the lobby areas of all on-campus housing communities.

Housing and Residence Life, in conjunction with the campus G.R.E.E.N. program have worked to place paper recycling bins in all of the on-campus housing communities. Residents can deposit recyclable paper products by placing them in these bins, located in the lobby of their respective community. Housing and Residence Life staff will collect the contents weekly to be put in the appropriate depositories. Currently, the University does not have a campus-wide program for recycling glass, plastics and cardboard.

WE HAVE A WINNER!

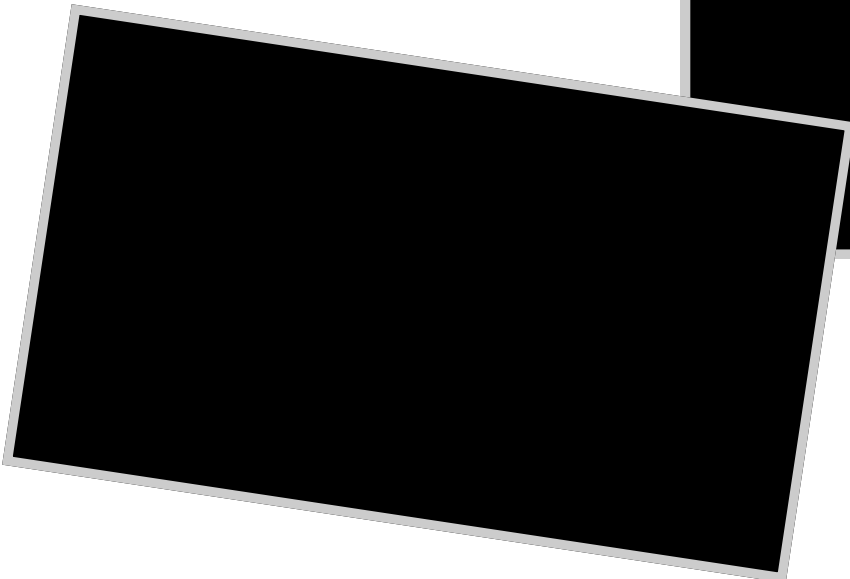
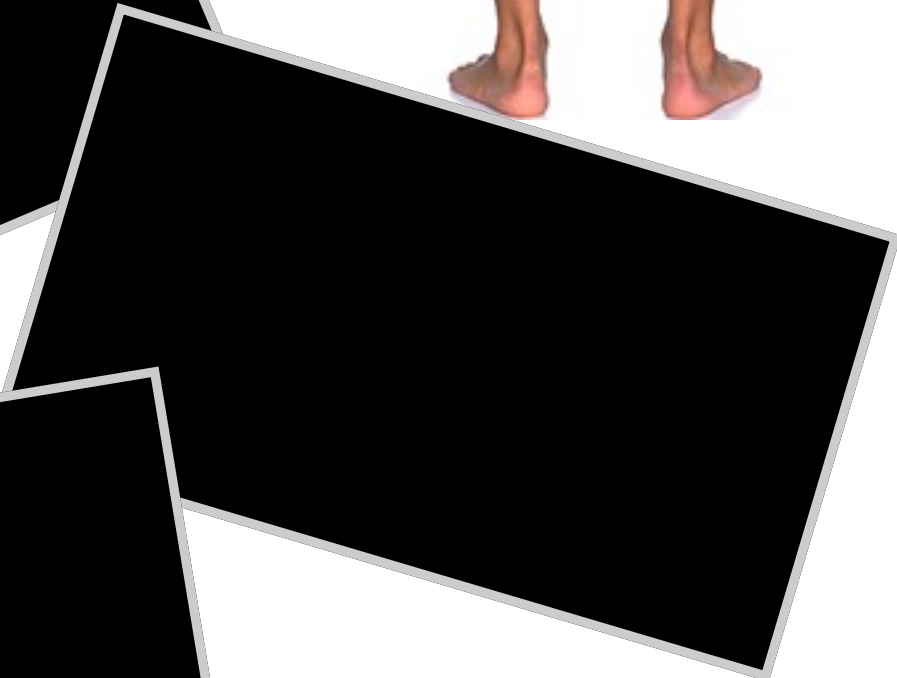
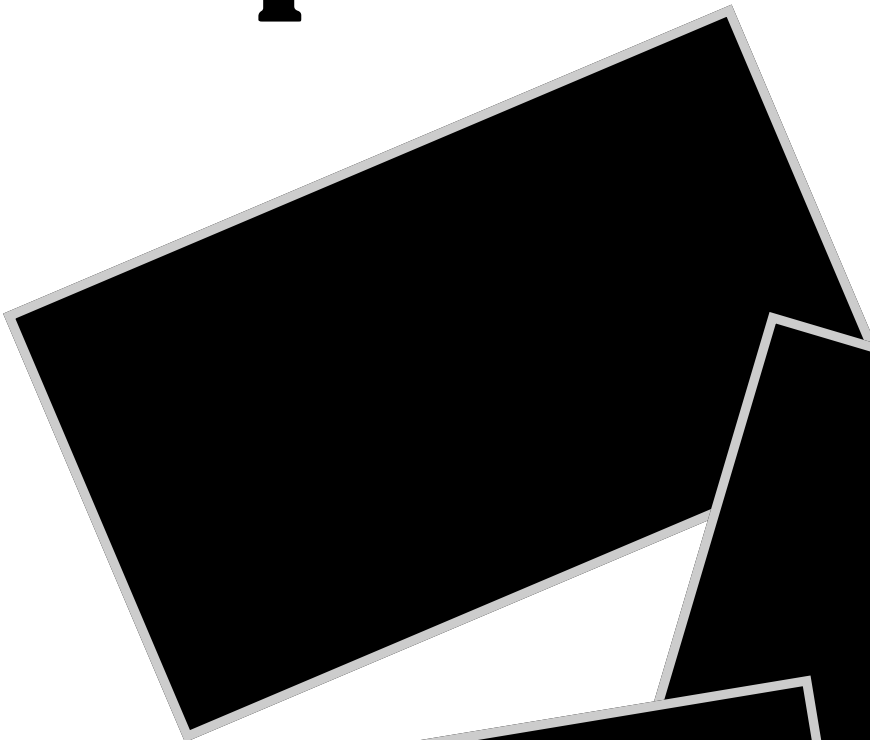
