SUBJECT: Tailgating Rules and Responsibilities

Tailgating is your opportunity to socialize and network with friends, colleagues, and other members of the university community. All student organizations are encouraged to tailgate and enjoy themselves. However, to ensure that tailgating takes place in a climate that is friendly and welcoming to all, you are reminded that the following rules must be adhered to:

- No pets are allowed (unless they are used to support persons with a disabling condition)
- No bottles are allowed
- No alcoholic beverages can be consumed by anyone under 21
- No food or beverage sales are allowed
- No music, language, or speech that can be construed as vulgar, profane, or hateful is allowed
