

## Letter of Notification and Agreement

This is an official notice to Jon James\_\_ (999-99-2010) that he is being placed under sanctions 2.85; 2.88; 2.89; 2.90 of the code of Student Conduct, which is are

- 2.85 Disciplinary Probation expiring December 31, 2011
- 2.88 Disciplinary Fine in the amount of \$175.00 to be paid at the Controller=s Office.
- 2.89 Community Service - to be completed under the supervision of Dr. Zulu Hours must be completed not later than August 1, 2010. Community Service will also include the successful completion of Alcohol 101.
- 2.90 Suspension of Rights and Privileges - You are evicted from the residence hall system for a period of not less than one year. The evictions also includes a ban from all residence halls during the period of probation. While you are on suspension you may only attend classes. You may not live in or visit any residence hall, you can not attend or participate in any campus activity and /or with any campus organization(on or off campus). Therefore you are directed to remove all your personal belongings from the residence hall and turn in all keys by immediately. Should you violate this directive, you will be arrested by University Police. **(Suspension will be waived pending the completion and compliance of all conditions of probation).**

### **These sanctions are the result of this student's violation of the Code of Student Conduct Sub-Section(s)**

- 1.6 Physical abuse or threat thereof including acts of intimidation against any person or persons ... including hazing, domestic violence or offensive touching.
- 1.2 Disorderly conduct, including noise that reaches a disruptive level... or the rights of members of the University Community or others.
- 1.2 Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages in any form on University premises or University-related premises, except in those areas of the University premises or University-related premises where the President or his/her designee has authorized the serving of legal beverages, subject to prescribed regulations. Providing, furnishing or causing to be furnished any alcoholic beverage to any person under the legal drinking age or any person in a state of noticeable intoxication on Violation of the University Alcohol Policy.
- 1.2 Violation of any published rules governing conduct in residence halls, dining halls, University Union, recreational Facilities or University related premises.

#### **As additional terms of the probation you will be required to:**

Seek anger management counseling to address your behavior relative to this incident. Counseling is not a punishment - it is an opportunity for you to address your issues and change your behavior so that you can lead a healthier academic and personal life. You may select the licensed counselor of your choice. Note that the University does have a Counseling Center in which services to students are free of charge. Any cost for outside services will be paid by you. You agree to: 1) permit the University to provide the counselor access to University records, 2) agree to permit the University to verify that you are seeking counseling services relative

to this matter, and 3) to permit University staff to speak to your counselor to determine whether it was a mutual agreement to discontinue counseling or whether you decided to discontinue counseling on your own.
