*NOTE: At least 25% of the discipline course hours in each undergraduate major MUST be taught by faculty members holding the terminal degree - usually the earned doctorate - in the discipline.

IMPORTANT: If a faculty member does not meet the guidelines stated above, and he/she is considered QUALIFIED BY EXCEPTION, the department head MUST complete a Faculty Qualification by Exception form and submit it to proper authorities for approval/signatures. This exception form MUST state <u>specific reasons</u> why the faculty member is qualified to teach the course(s). Please do NOT re-state degree information that is already noted on the faculty roster. Please note that ONLY qualifications specifically related to the course(s) being taught should be stated on the exception form.

SACS Core Requirement 3.7.1 states: "...The institution also considers competence, effectiveness, and capacity, including, as appropriate, undergraduate and graduate degrees, related work experiences in the field, professional licensure and certifications, honors and awards, continuous documented excellence in teaching, or other demonstrated competencies and achievements that contribute to effective teaching and student learning outcomes. For all cases, the institution is responsible for justifying and documenting the qualifications of all its faculty."
