†To earn the LT degree students will need to complete an additional 4 hours of electives in one or more of the categories listed above. Students who wish to complete the Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree will be required to complete 64 hours of course work once admitted into the Nursing program. To apply to the BSN clinical sequence students must have a minimum GPA of 2.75 in the first 35 hours (see highlighted courses) of the BSN curriculum, with no earned grade below the level of "C." All student applicants are ranked according to GPA, percentage of first 35 hours earned at Nicholls, and number of repeated courses in the first 35 hours. Qualification to apply does not guarantee acceptance into the clinical sequence of the BSN degree program.
