<u>STUDENT GOVERNMENT AMENDMENT #1</u> CHANGING THE AMOUNT ALLOWED THAT REQUIRES TABLING FOR ONE WEEK, A MOTION THAT EXCEEDS \$1,000 RATHER THAN \$500.

Article III, The Legislative Branch, Section 3, Powers and Duties, Number 1, Letter D, 1) of the Student Government Association Constitution will read:

 "<u>Table automatically until the following regular meeting fiscal legislation exceeding</u> <u>\$1,000</u>, with the exception of the budget as dictated by item B of this section. This rule may be waived by 2/3 vote of those Senators present and voting."

<u>STUDENT GOVERNMENT AMENDMENT #2</u> CHANGING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ELECTION COMMISSION BY INCREASING APPOINTMENTS FROM 5 TO 7.

Article V, The Election Commission, 1. Composition, Letter A of the Student Government Association Constitution will read:

<u>A. "The Election Commission shall consist of seven (7) appointed student members and one (1) ex-officio member."</u>

STUDENT GOVERNMENT AMENDMENT #3

CHANGING THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY OF THE ELECTION COMMISSION WHEREBY ALL APPOINTMENTS ARE JOINTLY MADE BY THE SGA AND SPA PRESIDENTS.

Article V, The Election Commission, 1. Composition, Letter A, 2) of the Student Government Association Constitution will read:

2) "The remaining six (6) members shall be appointed jointly by the SGA and SPA Presidents with a 2/3rds approval of those present and voting at a duly constituted meeting of the Senate."

<u>STUDENT GOVERNMENT AMENDMENT #4</u> CHANGING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE STUDENT SUPREME COURT FROM 7 TO 9 BY SGA & SPA APPOINTMENTS.

Article VI, The Judicial Branch, Section 2, Composition of the Student Government Association Constitution will read:

<u>"The Student Supreme Court shall be composed of nine (9) students, each appointed</u> jointly by the SGA and SPA Presidents with a 2/3rds approval of those present and voting at a duly constituted meeting of the Senate."
