

Estimated Cost of Attendance

Nicholls State University was named in the *U.S News & World Report College Rankings* as one of fifteen most affordable institutions for international students for 2022-2023. "Among the 544 ranked colleges that enrolled at least 25 international students, 15 have annual total costs below \$24,600, according to *U.S. News'* data."

Total costs will vary based on educational level, number of courses and personal living expenses. The Office of International Student Services calculates the following estimate based on full time attendance (the minimum number of credit hours required by U.S. immigration regulations). Full time is 12 hours in undergraduate, 9 hours in graduate.
