**\*\*\*Additional Information Regarding Education Courses and Questions:**

To qualify for EDUC 450, the student must have passed the Praxis PLT and 5161. Students should take EDUC 309/318, 313, 321, and 441 in their final year with residency courses EDUC 450 and 454. Students may take one MATH course (423 or 465) during Residency I and should take no more than 12 hours a semester during Residency I and II.
