## WHY NICHOLLS DANCE TEAM?

Nicholls State University Colonelettes Dance Team represents the University at football games, men and women basketball games, and baseball games. They also represent the University at other non-athletic functions such as student orientations, welcome back day, parades, competitions, and various events on and off campus.

#### MISSION STATEMENT

Nicholls State University Colonelettes Dance Team is committed to helping students show school spirit, achieve academically, and have creativity while growing both as a dancer and individual.

### **SERVICE AWARDS**

Members of the team will be awarded a service award at the conclusion of the Fall semester and Spring semester. Upon acceptance of membership, the student acknowledges the responsibility to be at ALL rehearsals, UDA camps, non-athletic functions, and performances involving the Colonelettes during the Fall and Spring Semesters. Failure to do so may result in a reduction of the service award and lowering of the grade. This is to be determined by the Band Director and Coach.

### **COMMITMENT**

Candidates selected on the team must schedule the Band Class <u>Music 191 or 391</u>. The class is from 2:00-4:00pm on Mondays, Wednesday's, and Fridays for the Fall Semester, and on Tuesdays and Thursdays 3:00-5:00pm in the Spring Semester. (<u>YOU MUST SCHEDULE YOUR CLASSES AROUND THIS PRACTICE SCHEDULE</u>). If one does not attend, it could affect your service award and grade.

Members of the team have commitments such as workout hours. They are <u>required</u> to attend NDA College Camp on July 22-24, 2022. Summer practices are held prior to camp in June and July (dates TBD). The team also reports for a <u>mandatory</u> Band Camp 1 week prior to the first day of school for the Fall Semester. Each Colonelette that makes the team is responsible for covering up to \$200 in personal expenses for apparel and accessories. <u>A \$100 payment is also needed as a membership fee</u>. This fee is due by August 15, 2022.

#### **FUNDRAISING**

All members of the team will contribute by fundraising in the Fall and Spring Semesters. Each member will be required to meet a certain amount to allow us to attend camps, purchase costumes, accessories, competition fees, and accommodation expenses.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

<u>Current and Transfer Students</u>: must be enrolled at Nicholls State University as a full-time (12 hours) student, with a current semester GPA of 2.0 minimum; an official copy of your transcript is required upon arrival of tryouts. Please have your GPA highlighted.

<u>For Incoming Freshman</u>: must have applied to the University and should be accepted prior to tryouts. A copy of the acceptance letter is required upon arrival of tryouts.

## **AUDITIONS/PROCESS/REQUIREMENTS**

Tryout Fee: \$25

We accept cash and checks or money orders. Please write a check out to Nicholls Foundation.

<u>Attire</u>: During auditions, the attire is black fitted crop top/sports bra (rhinestones may be added, no beads, no dangling accessories; must resemble a dance top), black dance shorts, jazz/half sole shoes, hip hop pants of your choice, and hip-hop shoes.

Hair: Middle Part, Low bun.

<u>Makeup</u>: As you would on game day (\*see page 6). Earrings are allowed. NO necklaces, ankle bracelets, rings or any other piercings such as; nose, lip, belly, eye brow, etc. Any tattoos you may have should not be visible.

#### **Tryout Process:**

All portions of the tryout are closed to the public, except the band director, judges, coach, and staff. Candidates will be evaluated on solo's, jazz/pom & hip-hop combination, technique, physical fitness/appearance, and interviews. Judging will be done with the clinic atmosphere. When finalizing the team, candidates who possess a strong work ethic are what we are looking for. Also, if the candidate is coachable and can easily make corrections, as well as get along with other members/candidates.

### **AUDITIONS BEGIN**

#### **FRIDAY, June 3, 2022**

Doors open/Check in begins at 7:30am: Candidates are encouraged to begin stretching/warming up at 8am (on their own).

- 30 to 45 Second Solo- candidates must arrive with a Solo to showcase to judges.
   All types of styles are accepted. Feel free to showcase your best work.
- Round 1 Cuts
- Jazz Combination- candidates learn a 1 minute combination by a professional choreographer. Candidates will perform this routine the next day to be judged.
- Hip Hop Combination- candidates will learn a 45 second combination by a professional choreographer. Candidates will perform this routine the next day to be judged.

#### SATURDAY, June 4, 2022

- Pom Combination- candidates will be taught an on the spot 45 second combination by a professional choreographer.
- Round 2 Cuts: Pom Combination
- Break
- Round 3 Cuts: <u>Jazz Combination</u> (CUTS if needed)
- Final Round: <u>Hip Hop Combination</u>

Interviews can take place at any time during auditions. Each applicant will perform in numerical order. Judges may ask for callbacks if necessary. Judges may also ask for technique in the list of requirements stated below at any time of the tryout session. CUTS are allowed to happen at any time during the audition.

- Music for Solo
- FRONT and BACK copy of your current health insurance card (must have insurance to tryout)

- Copy of Transcript with GPA highlighted
- Copy of Acceptance letter (incoming freshman ONLY)
- Solo: Must be a minimum of 30 seconds/Max 45 seconds. Please use this
  opportunity to showcase your strengths. Any style is welcomed.

Please submit items above as paper copies. Please bring the day of Auditions.

- Pique Turns
- Chaine Turns
- Second Turns (2 or more eight count combinations)
- Calypso
- Firebird
- Turning Disc
- Tilt Jump
- Left/Right Leaps
- Leap in Second
- Experience in all types of dance

# **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

- 1. What should I bring to tryouts?
  - Water, lunch/dinner, or personal items you may need during the tryout (hair pins, makeup, extra dance attire, etc.)
- 2. How do I submit my audition application, solo music, and insurance?
  - Please submit by email. <u>The registration deadline is May 28, 2022</u>.
- 3. How should I wear my hair and makeup?
  - Hair should be in a middle part/low bun. Makeup should be worn as you would on gameday/recital. Feel free to add lashes and red lips.
- 4. Will I be judged on height and weight?
  - We require dancers to maintain the appropriate physique in order to look their best in any uniform as well as execute all skills and choreography.
- 5. If I mess up can I do the routine again?
  - No, but the judges may ask for callbacks.
- 6. Can I maintain a job and dance team?
  - Yes, but Colonelettes must be a priority.
- 7. Will the Colonelettes compete at any competitions?
  - Yes, if the opportunity is given.
- 8. Do I need extra clothing for my interview and solo?
  - No. You will just need your audition attire.
